

VACCINATIONS FOR LOCAL ANIMAL CONTROL FACILITIES

In an effort to halt shelter disease outbreaks in their tracks, Prevent Unwanted Pets is now supplying core vaccinations for dogs entering Bay City, Eagle Lake, El Campo, Sealy and Brookshire animal control facilities. Risk of disease exposure is often high in shelters and the majority of animals entering these facilities have never received medical treatment or care. Vaccination of animals immediately upon entry can often protect them from, or significantly reduce the serious consequences of, canine distemper virus, canine parvovirus, and respiratory illness. This proactive measure will help ensure that individual adopters or rescue organizations that remove dogs from these facilities will receive a healthier or more adoptable pet.



We're Partnering to Save More Lives

Partnerships with other groups allows PUPS to move more healthy pets out of animal control facilities quickly so we can focus on the sick and injured that require more rehabilitation before they can find their forever homes. Through our partnership with Citizens for Animal Protection (CAP) and Special Pals, PUPS in recent months has transferred 100 + dogs and cats from area pounds to their facilities, resulting in 100 percent placement in their adoption programs and into loving homes; even a number of long term PUPS foster dogs found their forever homes through CAP!
